



### What do I need to attend a Course

To attend one of our NZTA approved courses you must hold your **Class 5 Learner Licence**.

To obtain a Class 5 Learners Licence you must have held a full current NZ Class 4 licence for more than 6 months, if you are under 25 years old. If you are over 25, you only need to hold it for 3 months.

### How do I get my Class 5 Learner Licence

You should study the Heavy Vehicle Road code. This can be purchased from a book store, borrowed from your local library or online via the NZTA website.

You will be given a computerised theory test. This will involve 35 questions a mixture of Class 5 and general road code questions.

### Where can I book my Learner Licence test?

At your local driver licencing agency: AA or VTNZ

You <b>must</b> take with you:	
<b>Medical Certificate</b>	<p><u>Must be less than 60 days old</u> (unless you have had one in the last 5 years for driver licencing &amp; your health hasn't changed)</p> <p>If you need one we advise that you do not get this until just before you are ready to book in at your licencing agency</p>
<b>Proof of Identification</b>	See NZTA Factsheet 20 for the acceptable ID required

**To attend the Class 5 course you must be able to hook, unhook, back/back around a corner as well as general on road driving**

On successful completion of the theory and practical assessments, you will be issued with a NZTA Course Certificate. You must:

- Take your course certificate to your local driver licencing agency along with Proof of ID
- Apply to have your Full Class 5 added to your driver licence

You will be issued with a 21-day temporary licence keep this on you whenever you're driving until your new driver licence arrives in the mail.

**What can I drive with a Full Class 5 Licence?**  
A combination vehicle with a gross combination weight of over 25,000kgs.
